The Lighting of the Advent Candles

The word advent, from Latin, means "the coming." It is a time of spiritual reflection as well as cheer and anticipation. The custom of lighting Advent candles is an old one. On the first Sunday of Advent, the family gathered around the fireplace. On the mantelpiece were four candles, surrounded by boughs of evergreen. The first candle was lit as the family read from the Bible, and sang and prayed together. On the second Sunday, the first candle was lit again, and then the second, as once again the family worshipped together and so on each week, until the circle of light was completed on the fourth Sunday of Advent. Then the center candle was lit on Christmas Eve in celebration of the birth of Jesus. An Advent wreath is made from greens to symbolize continuous life and contains five candles— three purple, one rose and a white candle placed the center of the wreath. We hope you find these weekly scripture readings encouraging and helpful as you and your family prepare for the celebration surrounding the Advent of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

First Sunday In Advent: The Prophecy Candle (Purple Candle)

We rejoice that God prepares our lives through prophecy to receive Christ when he comes. The words from Isaiah 9 prepare us to receive Christ as the child who comes to us in Bethlehem. They also prepare us to receive Christ when he comes again in power. At that time he will fulfill the promise to be Prince of Peace and Wonderful Counselor for all times and there will truly be no end to his gracious kingdom.

Scripture: Isaiah 9:1-7

"Gracious Lord, prepare our lives to receive your beloved Son as he comes to us in his birth and as he will come again in power at the close of the age.

Inspire us through prophecy to await him with joy. Amen."
